GOOD NEWS! ALL WSISD Students will receive **FREE MEALS** for the 2021-2022 school year! Students may have one free breakfast meal and one free lunch meal per day.

IMPORTANT: We ask that you go ahead and complete a Free/Reduced Meal Application for this school year. This will ensure that you will receive benefits for the first 30 days of the 2022-23 school year. You may also qualify for additional benefits (PEBT). WSISD receives additional funding for students based on those who qualify for the free and reduced meal program.

Purchasing a meal is the best deal for your money! To be charged the FREE meal price (instead of à la carte pricing) the student must take at **least 3** out of the 5 items offered and one of those items must be a fruit or vegetable choice.

The **five items** are: Protein; 1 Fruit choice except for high school they may have 2 fruits or 1 fruit and 1 juice; 1 of each Vegetable offered; a Bread/Grain choice; and Milk choice. Some of our items can count as 2 items, (Protein and Bread/Grain): Hamburger, Pizza, Sandwich, Spaghetti and meatballs. If a student only wants a few items they will be charged individual prices.
